FORGIVE US OUR SINS

DEVOTION: "...and forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us." ~Matthew 6:12 NLT

FORGIVE US OUR SINS: I have heard many preachers and Bible teachers teach that we are all sinners saved by grace. I am a Christian having confessed Christ that "believes that Jesus is the only begotten Son of God." These were not just words said; I sincerely believe from the heart that this is fact. I have been baptized into Christ and added to the saved (Acts 2:47). I find it hard to say, "I am a sinner." "I am now a Christian – a follower of Christ. A sinner is one who loves and practices sinning.

A man helped me to see this from another perspective. He said he was not a mechanic but does go out sometimes and work on his car; this does not make him a mechanic. He said that he is also a Christian who sometimes "sin" but he was not a "sinner." He was a Christian, one who follows Christ. This made sense to me. I have some thoughts but not all thoughts.

Another writer said, "If I had not confessed the sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened (Psalm 66:18 NLT). He further states, I've noticed that whenever I wear light-colored pants, I tend to spill on myself more often. What I've realized, however, is that I'm always spilling on myself. I just don't see the stains because I usually wear dark jeans. The same can be true of our lives. We sin more than we think we do. There are sins of commission and sins of omission. A sin of commission, of course, is doing what we shouldn't do. A sin of omission is not doing what we should do.

That's why it's a good thing to pray on a regular basis (daily or on an hourly basis), 'Forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us' (Matthew 6:12 NLT). Start there. Admit your sin. Don't make excuses for it. Own it. Repent of it. That establishes communication with your Father in Heaven.

The prophet Isaiah said, 'The Lord's arm is not too weak to save you, nor is his ear too deaf to hear you call. It's your sins that have cut you off from God. Because of your sins, he has turned away and will not listen anymore' (Isaiah 59:1-2 NLT).

If we don't confess our sins, it's like hanging up on God. There still may be a relationship, but our fellowship and communication with Him are temporarily severed.

Maybe you're thinking, 'I don't know whether I have any sins to confess.' If you spend any time in God's presence, you will be immediately aware of how much you're in need of God's forgiveness. The more we see God in His glory, the more we'll see ourselves in our sinfulness.'

As I write these devotions I search for thoughts that may be of benefit to others and me.

MEMORY VERSE: "If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. But if we confess our sins to Him, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. If we claim we have not sinned, we are calling God a liar and showing that His word has no place in our hearts." ~1 John 1:8-10 NLT

PRAY WITH US: Father in heaven, Your Son taught His Apostles to pray thusly, "Forgive our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. So I pray today that You will forgive me of my sins as I forgive those who sin against me. Forgive all my trespasses by word, thought or deed. In the name of Jesus the Christ I make these requests.
