TEST THE SPIRIT

Shepherd's Corner <u>**DEVOTION**</u>: "Dear friends, do not believe everyone who claims to speak by the Spirit. You must test them to see if the spirit they have comes from God. For there are many false prophets in the world." ~1 John 4:1 NLT

TEST THE SPIRIT: Occasionally, we hear someone say something, preach something, or teach something that doesn't sit well in our hearts. We have a nagging feeling that something just isn't quite right with what was said. The Holy Spirit within us

gives us a sick feeling in the pit of our stomachs — I call this feeling the "greasies" — letting us know that something isn't quite right. The things said could be very pleasing to us, they could be difficult for us to hear, or they could be the culturally acceptable point of view. No matter on what trajectory the comments reach us, we need to pray and seek the Spirit's leading and then open the Scriptures to check and see if what we heard is really from God. Spiritual discernment is an important work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. —Phil Ware

Sometimes we need reassurance that our relationships are still good. I do not know why. Maybe because we all have some insecurities. Maybe because difficulties, shortcomings or setbacks create insecurities in us. I do not know why, but I know we need it.

How many of us have talked with a child after he or she made a mistake; listened to a friend in distress; comforted a young adult after a break up; encouraged a spouse after a setback. We have done those things in part because we wanted people to know that despite mistakes, distress, breakups or failures that we still cared for them.

The need for a little reassurance can also apply to those of us IN CHRIST. We are placed IN CHRIST at baptism. And, at that point, we enjoy a special relationship with God. Salvation is in Christ.
