WHO IS ON THE LORD’S SIDE?

DEVOTION: *And all the people grumbled against Moses and Aaron. The whole congregation said to them, "Would that we had died in the land of Egypt! Why is the LORD bringing us into this land, to fall by the sword? Our wives and our little ones will become a prey. Would it not be better for us to go back to Egypt?" And they said to one another, "Let us choose a leader and go back to Egypt."* ~Numbers 14:2-4 ESV

WHO IS ON THE LORD’S SIDE?: We're living in difficult times. Enemies that were fought and defeated long ago are rising once again. Demons and dark powers and legions of evil forces are working their way into our communities, our schools, and our families. And some of us are going over to the dark side. Some are rebelling against godly leaders who are fighting for truth and righteousness and calling for a return to Egypt. Unafraid of those who are in opposition they cry out, "Do not rebel against the LORD!" But the people are picking up stones. Indeed, these are difficult times. 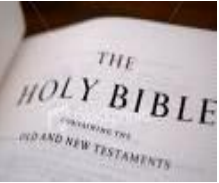
